## **Notes for Guidance**

- 1. Ardglass Golf Club's membership year runs from January 1st to December 31st.
- Membership application may be made under any one of the following categories:
  7 Day, 6 Day, 5 Day, Under 25 year old, Novice, External, International, Junior,
  Juvenile or House membership.
- 3. Only 7 Day, 6 Day, 5 Day, Under 25 year old and External members are entitled to voting privileges.
- 4. A Novice member cannot be a past member of Ardglass or any other golf club, and can only remain within this novice category for one year.
- 5. The names and addresses of all applicants will be posted within the Clubhouse for a period of 14 days to allow existing members to opine on any nomination.
- 6. Applicants may be asked to attend an interview prior to their nomination going forward to the Club's Council meeting.
- 7. All applications will go before the members of the Club's Council for their approval or otherwise.
- 8. All applicants will be advised in writing of the outcome of their application. No other correspondence or communication will be entered into regarding same.
- 9. If you hold membership in more than one club you must select, and take your handicap, from the club where you play the majority of your competition golf. The club so chosen will be deemed to be your "home" club.
- 10. The Club's Privacy Policy is available to download from the Club's website. The paper copy of your application will be destroyed after seven years while an electronic copy may be retained. In the event that you leave Ardglass Golf Club, the Club reserves the option to hold your details for up to ten years.
- 11. International members may invite a total of three special rate guests in any one year. These guests will be charged the equivalent of the GUI/ILGU member green fee rate. Other guests of International members will be subject to the normal green fee rates applicable at the time of their visit.
- 12. Except for signatures, your application form should be completed in block capitals.
